SCHEDULE D PURCHASING REGULATIONS

- 1. Projects between four and ten thousand dollars (\$4,000 and \$10,000)--The notice inviting bids shall be a published notice and may, in addition, be supplemented by mailed notice to contractors registered pursuant to Section 20150.6. Publication of pursuant to this section shall be in a newspaper of general circulation, mailed or posted pursuant to this section. The county may also publish notice inviting bids in a trade publication.
- 2. Public projects of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) or more shall, in all instances, be let to contract by formal bidding procedure.
- 3. Projects of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) and more--the notices inviting formal bids shall state the time and place for the receiving and opening of sealed bids and distinctly state the project to be done. The first publication or posting of the notice shall be at least 10 days apart, in a newspaper of general circulation, the project done without further complying with this article.
- 4. It shall be unlawful to split or separate into smaller work orders or projects any public project for the purpose of evading the provisions of this article requiring public projects to
